

Research project - Exploring Community Support for Parents with Learning Disabilities

The University of York, in partnership with York People First, is working on a research project to explore how community resources and networks can support parents with learning disabilities, and enable them to feel part of their communities.

The research team are running focus groups to talk to professionals about their experiences of supporting parents with learning disabilities. The focus groups will explore:

- Supporting parents to access community resources;
- Developing parents' social networks; and
- Using strengths-based approaches to connect parents within their communities.

The groups will run online and involve professionals from across the country, so it'll be a good opportunity to chat with others in a similar line of work.
